

New Parishioner or Active Parishioner Status

It is expected that families who seek admission to Immaculata Catholic School as Catholics must meet the following criteria; the family is registered in a parish and the family should be regularly practicing their faith through worship services, stewardship (parish activities, ministries) and consistent identifiable financial support.

Families who are relocating to the Durham area must submit the parish affiliation form or a letter by their current pastor in order to be eligible for the participating parishioner rate. The Catholic transfer status will be valid for a six-month period after the start of school. After this time, a new parish affiliation must be submitted and signed by a local pastor.

Each parish commits \$450 per parishioner-student enrolled at Immaculata. This represents your parish community's commitment to Catholic education.

Each year we inform the pastor of your parish of the enrollment of your children at Immaculata. The pastor then lets us know whether or not you are active parishioners. Please note that your pastor (and not Immaculata staff) decides who is an active parishioner. Contact your pastor for further information.

We encourage you to be active in your parish. Your application will not be considered complete without the active parishioner verification letter.
