



ROMAN CATHOLIC PARISH AFFILIATION STATUS

The tuition rate for Catholic students at Immaculata Catholic School is substantially lower than that of non-affiliated students. This is because each parish makes a contribution to Immaculata that enables the school to offer a lower tuition rate. Without this form, signed by your pastor, your family will be classified as a non-participating parishioner and charged the non-affiliated tuition rate. **Your status as a participating parishioner requires annual verification with your parish pastor.**

Families who are relocating to the Durham area must submit a letter from their current pastor in order to be eligible for the participating parishioner rate. The Catholic transfer status will be valid for a six-month period after the start of school. After this time, a new parish affiliation must be submitted and signed by a local pastor.

It is expected that families who seek admission to Immaculata Catholic School as Catholics must meet the following criteria:

- 1) the family is registered in a parish;
- 2) the family should be regularly practicing their faith through worship services, stewardship (parish activities, ministries) and consistent identifiable financial support.
- 3) provide proof of child/children's Baptism or as Baptized parent provide proof of child's participation in faith formation leading to Baptism as recognized by the Catholic Church.
