## Coronavirus Readiness

The Immaculata school administration is closely monitoring the spread of coronavirus under the directives of the Diocese of Raleigh and the Durham County Department of Health. For the health and safety of our school community, teachers and custodial staff are continuing to sanitize shared surfaces like water fountains, desks, chairs, doorknobs, and railings and have hand sanitizer available in each classroom with proper handwashing hygiene signs in all of the bathrooms. Please remind students to wash their hands, sneeze into their elbows, keep hands away from their faces, and avoid interacting with anyone who may be sick.

**If a child or staff member exhibits symptoms like fever, vomiting, diarrhea, muscle aches, persistent cough and/or headache, s/he must stay home from school until s/he is symptom-free for 24 hours (or cleared by a physician).**

While the intent is not to cause alarm, school administration is being proactive and cautious for the protection of our community. Should the need arise, a detailed plan is already in place for school-wide distance learning. Updates will be sent as needed.
