Dear Immaculata Community:

To help slow the spread of novel coronavirus (COVID-19) and keep our community healthy, we are implementing the following social distancing measures under the directives of the CDC, Diocese of Raleigh, our pastor, Father Chris, the Immaculata Advisory Committee, and our new medical task force that is comprised of Immaculata parents who work in the healthcare field:

All gatherings of 50 people or more will be canceled or postponed, including but not limited to:

- Morning care - Doors will open at 7:30am to allow for our full faculty and staff to be in place and ready to receive students in their classrooms.
- Religious services - School Masses, Friday Morning Prayer, Stations of the Cross
- School Assemblies – Faith & Fun Across Europe, Information Session & Tour for prospective families
- Home & School Association events - Me & My Guy Game Night, Honor Roll Breakfasts, Spirit Nights, Book Fair, H&SA meetings
- Offsite events – Battle of the Books, Field trips, Kings Dominion Festival of Music

Additional precautions include:

- One adult per family may enter to the building to drop off a PreK or tardy student or pick up a student who is dismissing early (prior to 2:30pm). Essential volunteers such as lunch servers and private therapists/specialists may enter the building. No other adults will be permitted inside until further notice.
- Outside food will not be allowed, including birthday treats and pies for Pi Day.
- Lunches will be held in classrooms.
- Recess periods will be staggered to allow for smaller groups.
- Athletic teams will practice and play games in a closed setting (athletes and coaches only). After school activities with small groups of students like clubs, play practice, and choir will not be affected.

We will make every attempt possible to create online/virtual experiences to replace in-person events that have been canceled or closed to the community.

We appreciate your cooperation during this uncertain time and will keep you updated if there are any further changes in protocol.
