Students

- Distance learning is mandatory. Check your assignments daily.
- Make schoolwork the priority for your day.
- Read directions carefully, complete assignment thoroughly, and continue to produce quality work!
- Find a quiet, organized space without distractions (TV, phone, tablets, etc.) to work.
