APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Immaculata Catholic School offers need-based, partial tuition assistance to students in Kindergarten-Grade 8. We are not able to offer financial assistance for PreK or After School Care, but both may be eligible for dependent care reimbursement through your employer.

Families applying for tuition assistance must complete the online application and submit all required documentation to **FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment**. This should be done at the time the initial admissions application is submitted and annually thereafter. Visit immaculataschool.org/tuition for more details.

The following steps are required for FACTS to process your application:

- Complete the online application (paper applications will not be accepted). FACTS will process one application per household, so do not submit multiple applications for siblings.
- Submit copies of your 2017 IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A or 1040-EZ U.S. Individual Income Tax Return (2 pages), including all supporting tax Schedules C or C-EZ, Schedule E, Schedule F, Depreciation Form 4562, S Corporation Form 1120S (4 pages) & Schedule K-1 and Form 8825, Partnership Form 1065 (4 pages) & Schedule K-1 and Form 8825, Estates and Trusts Form 1041 & Schedule K-1. If applicant and co-applicant file separately, we require both tax returns for the same tax year. FACTS does NOT accept State tax returns.
- Submit copies of all 2018 W-2 Wage statements and Tax Returns for both you and your spouse by May 1, 2019.
- Submit copies of all supporting documentation for household Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Workers' Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).
- **The deadline to apply is February 15, 2019.**

Please allow three to four weeks for processing. Check the email address you provided to FACTS for notices indicating missing information or documents. No more than 50% of the parish tuition rate will be awarded to an individual, with priority given to parishioners. New students will be notified of awards at the time of enrollment acceptance.
